

Dear Parents, Faculty, Staff and Students,

I regret to inform you that as of late Sunday afternoon, we received unequivocal word from various Egyptian authorities that despite numerous messages to the contrary, we, along with every other school in Egypt, will need to close from Monday, November 30 through Thursday, December 3. School will resume for all students on Sunday, December 6. We recognize that this is contrary to the information we have been disseminating, and clearly, the lateness of this notification is some indication of our belief that we would be open as planned.

As was the case in our last forced closure, the campus will be open after school during community hours. Further information on virtual learning will be forthcoming tomorrow. Please ask your students to log onto Blackboard for specific instructions. As you know, we have learned a great deal from our last forced closure and we feel confident of engaging all students during this brief period.

We recognize that this communication is difficult and places some doubt in your mind regarding the reliability of information coming from CAC. Our firm intention is to continue to be forthcoming with all information as it emerges, and then to work to the best of our ability to provide quality, continuous education for your children. In most cases, the most expeditious source of information regarding your child is each school Principal. I am also happy to provide further information to any and all inquires, either by e-mail or by phone.
