Mr. Langbauer, an experienced mathematics teacher with over twenty years of teaching service: he has National Board Certification in adolescent and young adult mathematics; he is a frequent presenter of National Council of Teachers of Mathematics national conventions; co-authored and published an article entitled, "Teaching Mathematics through Problem Solving" (2003); selected as a PBS demonstration teacher for a video series entitled, "Math Line" (1996); presented at a number of National Council of Teachers of Mathematics Regional Meetings throughout the United States; conducted teacher training mathematics workshops for school districts throughout the United States; and was presented the Coca-Cola Teacher of Excellence Award in 2001.

Mr. Langbauer is scheduled to meet CAC parents at the **High School Mathematics Forum** on **Tuesday, September 10 at 7:00 p.m.** in the Gallery. Please come and join us, and learn more about the Integrated Mathematics program we are offering in the high school. We look forward to seeing you at this important session.
