

Please read the information below carefully to guide you through the first day:

Preschoolers (ages 4-5 yrs):

- Preschoolers will meet the first day in room 600 located on the ground floor of the building to your right as you enter the campus. Please bring your child 10 minutes before the start of his/her 1st class.
- Each pre-school group will be accompanied by two aides all day to assist them. Please communicate special requests/instructions to the aide.
- Preschooler should bring a morning snack, a full lunch with several beverages.
- Preschoolers enrolled in swimming should bring a swimsuit, a towel, goggles, and sunscreen if they are enrolled in swimming.
- Please label all personal belongings.
- Please drop off/pick up your child in/from room 600.

Please read the information below carefully to guide you through the first day:

Day Camp:

- Campers will be divided in to groups according to their ages and will be escorted by an aide all day long.
- The first day of the session, campers should report to the pool office at 7:50 a.m. Your counselors will be waiting for you there with a copy of your schedule.
- 10:00 a.m. you will be escorted to the lunchroom where you will spend a twenty minute break before your next class @10:20.
- 10:20 a.m. your counselors will pick you up from the lunchroom to escort you to the following class.
- 12:20 p.m. lunch time. You can either sit in the lunchroom or outside. Make sure you sit in the shaded areas.
- 12:55 p.m. return to the lunchroom and wait for your counselor to escort you to the following class.

Enrichment Classes:

Students signed up for individual classes will meet in the ES lunchroom located on the ground floor of the building to your right as you enter the campus. Please plan on coming 10 minutes before the start of your 1st class.

If you have a copy of your schedule, go straight to the lunchroom where your instructor will be waiting for you. If you need a copy, please pick up a copy from the registration staff as you enter the room.

For the 1st day your instructor will pick you up and drop you off in the lunchroom. Starting the second day you are on your own. If you are not sure where you should be, go to room 600 for help or as one of the summer program aides dressed in orange t-shirts to assist you.
